Latino voters across party lines share a strong commitment to protecting the ocean, reducing pollution, and defending the natural resources that sustain our families, cultures, and communities.

The 2026 National Azul Poll shows that these priorities extend beyond traditional political divides and offer common ground for meaningful action.

Republican Latino voters stand out across the findings featured below, registering support above the overall average for every question.

Their responses challenge assumptions about partisan divisions and show decision-makers that ocean conservation and environmental protections can command broad support across the Latino electorate.
